Class 4 – Open Roadster Shoeing

Time Allowed: 60 Minutes

One _ Fullered shoe with a toe clip, to be applied to a horse's foot provided made from flat steel bar.

One to be made to the judge's specification made from flat steel bar.

Timekeeping: Rounds will start and finish on the bell. Anyone still working after the bell will not score on that section i.e. Nail and finish or Specimen. Timings will be called out to all competitors at regular intervals during each round.

All materials provided and work completed remains the property of the Lincolnshire county Show.

Strikers may be used in all classes.

Judges decision is final.

Entries will be taken on a first come first served basis.
